# How does Supported Employment work?

**Supported Employment** assists individuals in both obtaining and maintaining community-based employment. P.I. job coaches support individuals in determining employment opportunities they are interested in and in finding a job. Job coaches also support individuals to fill out applications, prepare resumes and perfect interview skills.

Once a job is obtained, a job coach assists individuals to learn job responsibilities, culture and values of the work environment, job accommodations and explaining how employment affects their benefits.

Supported Employment serves adults age 18 and older who are diagnosed with a developmental and/or intellectual disability.
